

BYLAW NO 6-2017

A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE DISPOSAL OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL WITHIN THE RESORT VILLAGE OF BEAVER FLAT

The Council of the Resort Village of Beaver Flat in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the Construction Material Disposal Bylaw.
2. For the purposes of this bylaw the expression:
 - a) "Construction" shall mean construction of a new building, renovation of an existing building or construction or renovation of any improvement on the property (ie deck).
 - b) "Roll-off Container" means a garbage disposal container holding a minimum of 12 yards of waste. Said Roll-off Container may be rented from a garbage disposal company.
 - c) "Municipality" means the Resort Village of Beaver Flat.
3. During the construction of any building or improvement within the municipality the property owner doing said construction, or the contractor acting on behalf of the property owner, must obtain and use a Roll-off Container.
4. The Roll-off container must be placed on the property owner's property where the building or improvement is being constructed and must be in place prior to any construction beginning.
5. The property owner or contractor acting on behalf of the property owner is responsible for cost of the use of the Roll-off Container including delivery, disposal and removal.
6. Only waste material as allowed at the landfill where the waste is being disposed of may be placed in the Roll-off Container. The property owner shall be responsible for any deviations from this.
7. This bylaw shall come into effect as of the final passing.
