

## Bylaw No.7 – 2017

A Bylaw of the Resort Village of Beaver Flat to provide for backflow prevention.

NOW THEREFORE THE RESORT VILLAGE OF BEAVER FLAT ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

### DEFINITIONS

1. In this bylaw:
  - a) "Backflow" means the reversal of the normal direction of flow of water or sewer;
  - b) "Backflow Prevention Device" means a device that prevents backflow;
  - c) "Municipality" means the Resort Village of Beaver Flat;
  - d) "Owner" means any person, firm or corporation having control over property to which the Bylaw applies and includes the owner registered on the title of the property and any occupant of any building or structure located on such property;

### APPLICABLE PROPERTIES

2. This Bylaw applies to all properties located within the Resort Village of Beaver Flat.

### BACKFLOW PREVENTION

3. Every owner of property within the Municipality shall ensure that a backflow prevention device is installed in respect of the sewer septic tank. The backflow prevention device shall be of CSA Standard.
4. Every owner of property within the Municipality shall ensure that the backflow prevention device is in proper working order at all times.
5. No bypass piping or other device capable of reducing the effectiveness of a backflow prevention device shall be installed.
6. Failure to provide backflow prevention devices as set out in this bylaw shall result in the discontinuation of delivery of water from the Municipality.

### FINES

7. Every owner of property within the Municipality that contravenes any provision of this Bylaw or fails to comply with an Order issued by the Municipality's Building Inspector is guilty of an offence up to \$1,000 and is responsible for any water or sewer damage that may occur as a result of the failure to comply with this Bylaw.

COMING INTO FORCE

8. This Bylaw shall be applicable for any new construction or renovations as well as when property owners are replacing the sewer septic tank as of the final date of passing.
