

RESORT VILLAGE OF BEAVER FLAT  
BYLAW NO. 9/97

A BYLAW TO RESTRICT ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE IN THE RESORT VILLAGE OF  
BEAVER FLAT

The Council of the Resort Village of Beaver Flat in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Interpretation

1. For the Purpose of this bylaw the expression:

- (a) "All Terrain Vehicle" means all terrain vehicle as defined in The All Terrain Vehicle Act
- (b) "Crown Land" means Crown Land as defined in the Highway Traffic Act
- (c) "Highway" means a highway as defined in the Highway Traffic Act
- (d) "Private Land" means land other than public land
- (e) "public Land " means public land as defined in The Terrain Vehicles Act
- (f) "Vehicle" means a vehicle as defined in the Highway Traffic Act

- 2. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any private or public property within the corporate limits of the Resort Village of Beaver Flat
- 3. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any owned or leased property within the corporate limits of the Resort Village of Beaver Flat
- 4. No person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any Crown Land which parcels of land are within the Resort Village of Beaver Flat
- 5. Any person in violation of this Bylaw shall be subject to punishment under the General Penalties Bylaw No. 1/97.
