

BYLAW NO. 10-2008

A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF BEAVER FLAT TO PROVIDE FOR THE SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE OF PEOPLE AND THE PROTECTION OF PEOPLE AND PROPERTY.

Pursuant to Section 8(1)(b) of The Municipalities Act, the Council of the Resort Village of Beaver Flat, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That the following activities with in the Resort Village of Beaver Flat be **prohibited unless approved by Council:**

- (a) Any construction, landscaping or earthmoving on village property.
- (a) Erecting or removal of any structures, signs or obstacles on village property.
- (b) Planting , removal or pruning of trees, shrubs or other vegetation on village property.

2. That the following activity within the Resort Village of Beaver Flat be **prohibited:**

- (a) No person shall cause or permit to be caused any dumping of trash, refuse, garbage, industrial waste, wood products or any other waste material.

3. Every person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw of the municipality is

guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:

- (a) For each offence committed by an individual, imposing a fine not exceeding \$10,000.00.

3. Bylaw No. 3-2008 is hereby repealed
